Ingredients & Supplies

7429 Realistic Dragon
FS-2314 Black Lab
FS-2300 Polar Bear
FS-2387 Pool Party
FS-2305 Blue Heaven
FS-2396 Anchors Away
FS-2375 Jumpin' Jelly
FS-2341 Kermit
6414 Hydra 3" Sponge
6673 Round Brush #6
6674 Round Brush #4
6677 Detail Brush



Directions

Step 1 Paint 1 coat of Black Lab on the entire piece. Let dry slightly, then with a clean damp sponge, wipe off the Black Lab. Black will be left in all the crevices.

Step 2 Using a #6 Round Brush and Pool Party paint 3 coats to both sides of the wings.

Step 3 Beginning in the corner of the wings and working outward, sponge Blue Heaven. As you move down the wing mix Pool Party with the Blue Heaven on the sponge. This will create a smooth gradation of color along the wings.

Step 4 Using the #4 round brush, paint the dragon's striped underside with 3 coats of Pool Party. Then paint 2-3 coats of Anchors Away on the scaly top-side. Paint a little lighter near the neck area and darker on the head. Paint 1-2 coats of Jumpin' Jelly on the top ridge of the wing (see photo).

Step 5 Using the #4 round brush, paint 1 light coat of Kermit on the left side of the rocks to give the illusion of moss growing on the stones.

Step 6 With a detailed brush, paint Black Lab on the tongue, claws and eyes. Add highlights to each eye with a dot of Polar Bear.

Step 7 Dip in Dazzle Dip Clear Glaze and fire to cone 06.
